- Birth: unknown
- Death: Aug. 29, 1884
- Inscription:
 - Remember, friends, etc.
 - 19y 10m 12d; wife of S. HEROD.

James Giffin Timeline:

1850 U.S. Federal Census - Canaan, Morrow, OH

Living in household:

- his children, Catherine & Henry;
- his grandchildren:
 - Loomis and George Herod (mother - Ellen (Giffin) Herod);
 - James, 19, Isabel, 17, and Mary Davis, 12. (mother - Mary Ann (Giffin) Lewis) [Samuel Davis, 16, resides with daughter Ellen Herod.]

1853 - Jackson, Bremer, IA

Wife Jane dies and buried at West Point Cemetery.

1860 U.S. Federal Census - Jackson, Bremer, IA

James living with daughter Catherine and grandson George Washington Herod.

1869 - Trenton, Grundy, OH

James dies and buried in Stepp Cemetery.

Ellen (Giffin) Herod Hann Netherton Timeline:

1838 - Marion Co, OH

- Ellen marries Thomas Herod. (Marion Co is now Morrow Co.)

1840 U.S. Federal Census - Marion Co, OH

- Census says that there is one girl under 5 and one boy between 5-9 living in household.

bef Jul 1850 - Ohio

- Husband Thomas Herod has died.

1850 U.S. Federal Census - Canaan, Morrow, OH

- Ellen's mpoverished.
- Children: Louisa, Loomis, Salathiel, George, William and Rhoda.
- Also living with her is her nephew Samuel Davis, 16 yrs. Could Samuel be same boy listed in 1840 census?
- Some children also listed in her father's household.
- Living next to Thomas' parents, James and Rhoda (Mills) Herod.

abt 1851 - Canaan, Morrow, OH

- Ellen marries John Hann.

1860 U.S. Federal Census - Wayne, Starke, IN

- Gideon is only child living with Ellen and husband John Hann.
- Louisa married to Robert Taylor Barge.
- Loomis working as farm laborer in Railroad Twp, Starke, IN.
- Salathiel working as farm laborers Kankakee, Jasper, IN.
- George W. living with Ellen's father, James Giffin, in Jackson, Bremer, IA.
- Location of William is unknown.

1862 - Starke Co, IN

- Ellen marries William Netherton.

1870 U.S. Federal Census - Wayne, Starke, IN

- Married to William Netherton, but living with sons Salathiel Herod and Gideon, whose last name is listed as Herod instead of Hann.
- Two unidentified girls living in household - Mary Kris, 1, born in Indiana, and Jeannette A Morris, 11, born in Ohio.

1880 U.S. Federal Census - Lincoln, Grundy, MO

- Ellen living with son Salathiel.
- Her other son George W. Herrod is living in Liberty, Grundy, MO.

May 1882 - Starke Co, IN

- Ellen dies and buried in Pioneer Cemetery in North Judson, IN.
